AN ACT

- 2 relating to delinquent payment of an alcoholic beverage retailer's
 3 account for liquor.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 102.32, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is 6 amended by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (d-1) The commission or administrator may not accept the
- 8 voluntary cancellation or suspension of a permit or allow a permit
- 9 to be renewed or transferred if the permit holder is delinquent in
- 10 the payment of an account for liquor under this section. A person
- 11 whose permit is canceled by the commission is not eligible to hold
- 12 any other permit or license under this code until the person has
- 13 cured any delinquency of the person under this section.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
