1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to delinquent payment of an alcoholic beverage retailer's
1-11 account for liquor.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 102.32, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
1-14 amended by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

1-15 (d-1) The commission or administrator may not accept the
1-16 voluntary cancellation or suspension of a permit or allow a permit
1-17 to be renewed or transferred if the permit holder is delinquent in
1-18 the payment of an account for liquor under this section. A person
1-19 whose permit is canceled by the commission or whose permit has
1-20 expired is not eligible to hold any other permit or license under
1-21 this code until the person has cured any delinquency of the person
1-22 under this section.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-27 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
