- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 31, Election Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 31.0925 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 31.0925. REQUEST FOR SERVICES REQUIRED. (a) This
- 9 section applies only to a political subdivision located entirely in
- 10 <u>a county:</u>

- 11 (1) with a population of more than 500,000 that is
- 12 served by a county elections administrator; and
- 13 (2) that does not contain a municipality with a
- 14 population of more than 150,000.
- 15 (b) The governing body of a political subdivision shall
- 16 request an election services contract with the county elections
- 17 administrator to perform all duties and functions of the political
- 18 subdivision in relation to an election that may be transferred
- 19 under this subchapter if the political subdivision receives a
- 20 petition requesting the contract signed by a number of registered
- 21 voters residing in the political subdivision that is equal to or
- 22 exceeds one percent of all votes cast in the most recent general
- 23 election held by the political subdivision.
- 24 (c) A petition under this section must be submitted to the

- 1 clerk of the political subdivision before January 1 of the year in
- 2 which the election to be administered under the requested election
- 3 <u>services contract will be held.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
