- 8 Sec. 202.061. AGREEMENT TO LOCATE CERTAIN CAMERAS ON

- 11 optical character recognition is used to read the license plate on a

- 13 (b) The department may enter into an agreement with the
- 14 Department of Public Safety, a federal law enforcement agency, or a

(d) The images produced from an automatic license plate 7 8 identification camera installed under an agreement authorized by this section may be used only for the purpose of: 10 (1) enforcing: (A) a penal law of this state, other than a 11 12 traffic law the violation of which is a misdemeanor punishable by fine only; or 13 14 (B) a penal law of the United States; 15 (2) locating: 16 (A) an abducted child for whom the statewide 17 alert system authorized by Subchapter L, Chapter 411, Government Code, has been activated; 18 19 (B) a missing senior citizen for whom a statewide silver alert authorized by Subchapter M, Chapter 411, Government 20 21 Code, has been activated; or 22 (C) a person for whom an alert has been issued under an executive order of the governor because the person has 23 24 seriously injured or killed a local, state, or federal law enforcement officer; or 25 (3) prosecuting a criminal offense, other than a 26 traffic law the violation of which is a misdemeanor punishable by 27

- 1 fine only, if the images are otherwise admissible in a judicial
- 2 proceeding.
- 3 (e) A person commits an offense if the person uses an
- 4 automatic license plate identification camera to produce an image
- 5 other than in the manner and for the purpose specified by this
- 6 <u>section</u>.
- 7 (f) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
