- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 34.001(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person who has filed an application for a place on the
- 8 ballot as provided by the Election Code for a judicial office listed
- 9 in Subsection (b) is subject to Canon 5 $[\frac{7}{2}]$, Code of Judicial
- 10 Conduct, and is subject to sanctions as provided by this chapter.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 34.003, Government Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 34.003. ATTORNEY. A candidate who is an attorney and
- 14 who violates Canon 5 $[\frac{7}{2}]$, Code of Judicial Conduct, or any other
- 15 relevant provision of that code is subject to sanctions by the state
- 16 bar.
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 34.004, Government Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 34.004. OTHER CANDIDATE. A candidate other than a
- 20 judge under Section 34.002 or an attorney under Section 34.003 who
- 21 violates Canon 5 [7], Code of Judicial Conduct, or any other
- 22 relevant provision of that code is subject to review by the attorney
- 23 general or the local district attorney for appropriate disciplinary
- 24 action.

- 1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
