- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 2251, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 2251.056 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2251.056. WAIVER OF IMMUNITY. A governmental entity
- 9 that fails to make an invoice payment to a vendor in the time
- 10 prescribed by this chapter waives sovereign or governmental
- 11 immunity from suit by the vendor to collect the invoice payment,
- 12 interest and attorney's fees due under this chapter, or any other
- 13 <u>amount due under this chapter.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 16 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- 17 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that
- 18 date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
