19	(b) In procuring cement, either directly or through a
20	subcontract, the department shall select a vendor that demonstrates
21	that the cement was produced from a portland cement kiln that:
22	(1) utilizes a dry raw material feed precalciner
23	pyroprocessing technology; and
24	(2) meets or exceeds regulatory requirements for

- 2 SECTION 2. Section 201.711, Transportation Code, as added
- 3 by this Act, applies only to a request for bids, proposals, or other
- 4 offers by or on behalf of the Texas Department of Transportation
- 5 that relates to a contract that involves the purchase of cement that
- 6 is published on or after September 1, 2009.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
