- 2 relating to the evaluation of certain regional planning

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) Before June 1, 2010, the state auditor
- 6 shall audit a regional planning commission created under Chapter
- 7 391, Local Government Code, that includes a county with a
- 8 population of 3.3 million or more, according to the most recent
- 9 federal decennial census. The cost of the audit shall be paid for
- 10 by the regional planning commission.
- 11 (b) On or before June 1, 2010, the state auditor shall
- 12 submit a report of an audit conducted under Subsection (a) of this
- 13 section to:
- 14 (1) the commissioners court of a county with a
- 15 population of 3.3 million or more, according to the most recent
- 16 federal decennial census, that is a member of a regional planning
- 17 commission described by Subsection (a) of this section; and
- 18 (2) the governing body of any other political
- 19 subdivision that is a member of a regional planning commission
- 20 described by Subsection (a) of this section, if the governing body
- 21 requests a report from the state auditor.
- (c) This section expires January 1, 2011.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
