8	CENTERS. (a) In this section, "community health center" means a
9	health organization that:
10	(1) is a nonprofit corporation under the Texas
11	Non-Profit Corporation Act (Article 1396-1.01 et seq., Vernon's
12	Texas Civil Statutes) and Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code
13	of 1986; and
14	(2) is organized and operated as:
15	(A) a migrant, community, or homeless health
16	center under the authority of and in compliance with 42 U.S.C.
17	Section 254b or 254c; or
18	(B) a federally qualified health center under 42

20	(b) The board by rule shall certify a health organization to
21	contract with or employ an optometrist or therapeutic optometrist

- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
