4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 531.051, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows:
7	(e) Section 301.251(a), Occupations Code, does not apply to
8	delivery of a service for which payment is provided under the
9	consumer-directed service option developed under this section if:
10	(1) the person who delivers the service:
11	(A) has not been denied a license under Chapter
12	301, Occupations Code;
13	(B) has not been issued a license under Chapter
14	301, Occupations Code, that is revoked or suspended; and
15	(C) performs a service that is not expressly
16	prohibited from delegation by the Texas Board of Nursing; and
17	(2) the consumer who receives the service:
18	(A) has a disability and the service would have
19	been performed by the consumer or the consumer's legally authorized
20	representative except for that disability; and
21	<u>(B) if:</u>
22	(i) the consumer is capable of training the
23	person in the proper performance of the service, the consumer
24	directs the person to deliver the service; or

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1 (ii) the consumer is not capable of 2 training the person in the proper performance of the service, the consumer's legally authorized representative is capable of 3 training the person in the proper performance of the service and 4 directs the person to deliver the service. 5 (f) If the person delivers the service under Subsection 6 7 (e)(2)(B)(ii), the legally authorized representative must be present when the service is performed or be immediately accessible 8 to the person who delivers the service. If the person will perform 9 the service when the representative is not present, the 10 representative must observe the person performing the service at 11 least once to assure the representative that the person performing 12

13 the service can competently perform that service.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
