- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 29.018 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 29.018. SPECIAL EDUCATION GRANT. (a) From funds
- 8 appropriated for the purposes of this section, federal funds, or
- 9 any other funds available, the commissioner shall make grants
- 10 available to school districts to assist districts in covering the
- 11 cost of educating students with disabilities.
- 12 (b) A school district is eligible to apply for a grant under
- 13 this section if:
- 14 (1) the district does not receive sufficient funds
- 15 under Section 42.151 for a student with disabilities to pay for the
- 16 services provided to the student; or
- 17 (2) the district does not receive sufficient funds
- 18 under Section 42.151 for all students with disabilities in the
- 19 <u>district to pay for the services provided to the students.</u>
- 20 <u>(c) A school district that applies for a grant under this</u>
- 21 section must provide the commissioner with a report comparing the
- 22 state funds received by the district for students with disabilities
- 23 and the expenses incurred by the district in providing services to
- 24 students with disabilities.

- 1 (d) Expenses that may be included by a school district in
- 2 applying for a grant under this section include the cost of training
- 3 personnel to provide services to a student with disabilities.
- 4 (e) A school district that receives a grant under this
- 5 <u>section must educate students with disabilities in the least</u>
- 6 restrictive environment that is appropriate to meet the student's
- 7 <u>educational needs.</u>
- 8 <u>(f) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to</u>
- 9 administer this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 11 school year.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
