- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 151.008, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.008. <u>BIENNIAL</u> [ANNUAL] REPORTING. <u>Not later than</u>
- 8 <u>December 1 of each even-numbered</u> [Each] year, the institute shall
- 9 provide to each member of the governing board of the institute and
- 10 to each member of the legislature whose district includes any
- 11 portion of a county where the Border Health Institute is
- 12 established or operating an [annual] audited financial statement
- 13 for each of the preceding two years and a status report of each
- 14 project undertaken by the institute.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
