1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to financial and status reporting requirements for the  
1-9 Border Health Institute.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 151.008, Education Code, is amended to  
1-12 read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 151.008. BIENNIAL [~~ANNUAL~~] REPORTING. Not later than  
1-14 December 1 of each even-numbered [~~Each~~] year, the institute shall  
1-15 provide to each member of the governing board of the institute and  
1-16 to each member of the legislature whose district includes any  
1-17 portion of a county where the Border Health Institute is  
1-18 established or operating an [~~annual~~] audited financial statement  
1-19 for each of the preceding two years and a status report of each  
1-20 project undertaken by the institute.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
