## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation and administration of a community-based
3	at-risk youth program.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 33, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter G to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER G. EDUCATION AND SELF-SUFFICIENCY PROGRAM
8	Sec. 33.251. PROGRAM. The agency, in conjunction with the
9	Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, shall administer the
10	Education and Self-Sufficiency Program as described by this
11	subchapter.
12	Sec. 33.252. STATE DIRECTOR. The commissioner shall
13	designate a state director for the Education and Self-Sufficiency
14	Program.
15	Sec. 33.253. DUTIES OF STATE DIRECTOR. The state director
16	shall coordinate community-based efforts to:
17	(1) assist students at risk of dropping out of school,
18	as defined by Section 29.081, to develop a foundation for a
19	well-balanced and appropriate education from early childhood
20	education through middle and junior high school through the use of:
21	(A) small school campuses that permit highly
22	personal learning environments and that offer a culturally
23	sensitive curriculum;

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(B) a variety of instructional and interactive

- 1 methods to develop self-respect, self-confidence, and students'
- 2 leadership skills; and
- 3 (C) after-school enrichment programs to help
- 4 students complete homework and improve academic skills;
- 5 (2) provide at least two years of mentoring for high
- 6 school students qualified and planning to pursue a postsecondary
- 7 education;
- 8 (3) provide vocational education training for high
- 9 school students who do not plan to pursue a postsecondary
- 10 education; and
- 11 (4) provide high school graduates who do not plan to
- 12 pursue a postsecondary education and parents of students adult job
- 13 training, including job readiness training and vocational
- 14 education training, and job placement assistance to assist those
- 15 <u>high school graduates and parents in transitioning from job</u>
- 16 training into the workforce.
- 17 Sec. 33.254. PARTICIPATION IN PROGRAM. A community-based
- 18 organization may participate in the program if the organization has
- 19 a proven track record of successfully working independently in an
- 20 area identified in Section 33.253.
- 21 Sec. 33.255. FUNDING; DONATIONS. (a) The state director
- 22 shall solicit and may accept federal funds, state funds, private
- 23 contributions, grants, and public and school district funds to
- 24 support the activities of the Education and Self-Sufficiency
- 25 Program.
- 26 (b) The state director may accept a donation of services or
- 27 money or other property that the state director determines furthers

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- 1 the lawful objectives of the program. Each donation, with the name
- 2 of the donor and the purpose of the donation, must be reported in
- 3 the public records of the program.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
