4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 5, Local Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 179 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 179. CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR FIREFIGHTERS OF
8	CERTAIN AIRPORT DISTRICTS
9	Sec. 179.001. APPLICABILITY. (a) This chapter applies to a
10	fire department of and firefighters employed by an airport district
11	created by an interlocal agreement between two or more political
12	subdivisions of this state.
13	(b) For purposes of this section, a reference to a
14	municipality or a municipal official in a provision of law made
15	applicable by this chapter to a district described by Subsection
16	(a) is considered to be a reference to the district or the official
17	of the district responsible for the performance of the duty to which
18	the provision applies.
19	Sec. 179.002. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "firefighter"
20	means a person defined as fire protection personnel under Section
21	419.021, Government Code.
22	Sec. 179.003. PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS; LONGEVITY PAY;
23	CLASSIFICATION PAY; PENALTY. (a) Sections 141.008, 141.032, and
24	141.033 apply to a firefighter employed by an employer covered by

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1 this chapter.

(b) The penalty under Section 141.035 applies to a person
who is in charge of the fire department under this section or who is
responsible for setting the compensation for firefighters employed
by an employer covered by this chapter.

<u>Sec. 179.004.</u> ASSISTANCE; BENEFITS; WORKING CONDITIONS;
<u>PENALTY.</u> Sections 142.001, 142.0013, 142.0015, 142.0016, 142.004,
<u>142.009</u>, and 142.010 apply to a firefighter employed by an employer
<u>covered by this chapter.</u>

10 <u>Sec. 179.005. CIVIL SERVICE. (a) An airport district to</u> 11 which this chapter applies is considered to have adopted Chapter 12 <u>143 as it applies to the airport district's fire department in the</u> 13 <u>same manner as a municipality with a population of less than 1.5</u> 14 <u>million to which that chapter applies, and Subchapters A-F, Chapter</u> 15 <u>143, apply to the district's fire department.</u>

(b) Each firefighter who has been in the service of the 16 17 airport district for more than six months at the time this chapter first becomes applicable to the airport district and who is 18 19 entitled to civil service classification has the status of a civil service employee and is not required to take a competitive 20 examination to remain in the position the person occupies at the 21 22 time this chapter first becomes applicable to the airport district. (c) The Fire Fighters' Civil Service Commission is 23 24 established in each airport district subject to this chapter. The chief operative officer of the airport district shall appoint the 25 26 members of the commission within 60 days after the date this chapter 27 first becomes applicable to the airport district. Within 30 days

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after the date the airport district's first full fiscal year begins
 after the date this chapter first becomes applicable to the airport
 district, the governing body of the airport district shall

4 implement this chapter.

5 <u>(d) The office of Director of Fire Fighters' Civil Service</u> 6 <u>is established in each airport district subject to this chapter.</u> 7 <u>The commission shall appoint the director. The director shall</u> 8 <u>serve as secretary to the commission and perform work incidental to</u> 9 <u>the civil service system as required by the commission. The</u> 10 <u>commission may remove the director at any time.</u>

11 SECTION 2. (a) On the effective date of this Act, Chapter 12 179, Local Government Code, as added by this Act, first becomes 13 applicable to an existing airport district.

(b) An airport district to which Chapter 143, Local Government Code, is, without regard to the holding of an election, applicable because of the change in law made by this Act shall implement a civil service system in the municipality in accordance with the terms of Subchapters A-F, Chapter 143, Local Government Code, and in accordance with Chapter 179, Local Government Code, as added by this Act.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
