A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to contracts entered into for the employment of the chief
3	executive officer of a public institution of higher education.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 51.9481 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 51.9481. REQUIRED PERFORMANCE REVIEW OF CHIEF
8	EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF INSTITUTION. (a) In this section,
9	"institution of higher education" has the meaning assigned by
10	Section 61.003.
11	(b) The employment contract of the president or other chief
12	executive officer of an institution of higher education must
13	provide for an annual evaluation of the president's or other
14	officer's performance. The evaluation must include consideration
15	of the following performance measures:
16	(1) development and encouragement of institutional
17	efforts to improve student retention and graduation rates;
18	(2) effective use and allocation of resources,
19	including faculty, staff, facilities, equipment, and financial
20	resources, to carry out the institution's mission and purposes;
21	(3) effective planning and budgeting to implement the
22	<pre>institution's objectives;</pre>

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soundness of the activities of faculty and students;

(4) efforts to ensure the academic quality and

- 1 (5) clear and effective leadership consistent with the
- 2 policies and decisions of the governing body of the institution;
- 3 (6) understanding of the different missions and
- 4 purposes among the academic divisions and programs of the
- 5 institution;
- 6 (7) effective recruitment and retention of capable and
- 7 recognized faculty;
- 8 (8) efforts to improve the quality of the
- 9 institution's academic programs, including obtaining professional
- 10 accreditation;
- 11 (9) effective human relations skills with
- 12 subordinates, alumni, the community, business and community
- 13 leaders, legislators and other state and local officials, and other
- 14 persons associated with the institution; and
- 15 (10) excellence in public relations within the
- 16 <u>institution and with persons outside the institution.</u>
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 51.9481, Education Code, as added by
- 18 this Act, applies only to an employment contract entered into or
- 19 renewed by the governing board of a public institution of higher
- 20 education with the chief executive officer of the institution on or
- 21 after the effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
