SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-19 1-20 1-21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-24 1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
