Article 102.016(b), Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) On conviction of an offense under Section 49.04, 49.045, 49.05, 49.06, 49.065, 49.07, or 49.08, Penal Code, the court shall 8 9 require the defendant to pay a \$45 breath alcohol testing program fee as a cost of court. The custodian of a municipal or county 10 11 treasury in a county that maintains a certified breath alcohol 12 testing program but does not use the services of a certified technical supervisor employed by the department may, to defray the 13 14 costs of maintaining and supporting the [a certified alcohol breath testing] program, retain [\$22.50 of] each court cost collected 15 16 under this article, in addition to any other court cost relating to a breath alcohol testing program to which the county is entitled 17 under Section 133.102, Local Government Code [Article 102.075 on 18 conviction of an offense under Chapter 49, Penal Code, other than an 19 offense that is a Class C misdemeanor]. 20 21 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 102, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 102.0412 to read as follows:

SECTION 4. Subchapter E, Chapter 102, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 102.0812 to read as follows:

13 <u>Sec. 102.0812. BREATH ALCOHOL TESTING PROGRAM FEE ON</u> 14 <u>CONVICTION IN COUNTY COURT: CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE. The clerk</u> 15 <u>of a county court shall collect from a defendant the fee imposed</u> 16 <u>under Article 102.016(b), Code of Criminal Procedure, on</u> 17 conviction.

SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only 18 19 to a fee collected on conviction of an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. A fee collected on conviction of an 20 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is covered 21 by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former 22 23 law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this 24 Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 25

26 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
