## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
8	amended by adding Section 61.0823 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 61.0823. STATEWIDE SPECIALIZED TECHNOLOGY RESEARCH
10	DATABASE. (a) The board shall collect data and maintain a database
11	relating to specialized technology research projects that are
12	developed or conducted at institutions of higher education,
13	research facilities of institutions of higher education, or other
14	facilities operated by a state agency in order to facilitate
15	coordination among the institutions and facilities on the projects.
16	(b) The database must include:
17	(1) a list of any projects involving one or more of the
18	following areas:
19	(A) energy research, including methods of
20	creation, storage, distribution, and conservation of energy;
21	(B) biomedical science research;
22	(C) nanotechnology research, including
23	nanomedicine; and
24	(D) other specialized technology research;
