13	(b) Each health and human services agency described by
14	Subsection (a) shall provide the information regarding
15	velocardiofacial syndrome to appropriate health care coordinators
16	and therapists and to parents of a child who is known by the agency
17	to have at least two of the following conditions:
18	(1) hypotonicity;
19	(2) communication delay;
20	(3) articulation disorder;
21	(4) resonance disorder;
22	(5) nasal regurgitation during feeding as an infant
22 23	(5) nasal regurgitation during feeding as an infant with no history of a cleft palate;

- 1 cardiac anomaly, feeding disorder, cleft palate, or submucosal

- 3 (7) fine motor or gross motor skills delay.
- 4 (c) The commission shall develop the information required
- 5 under Subsection (a) using medically accurate, peer-reviewed
- 6 literature. The information must include:
- 7 (1) an explanation of velocardiofacial syndrome
- 8 symptoms, diagnosis, and treatment options;
- 9 (2) information on relevant state agency and nonprofit
- 10 resources, parent support groups, and available Medicaid waiver
- 11 programs; and
- 12 (3) a recommendation for follow-up with a health care
- 13 provider for evaluation of the underlying etiology and an
- 14 explanation that the existence of any of the conditions listed in
- 15 Subsection (b) will not necessarily result in a diagnosis of
- 16 <u>velocardiofacial syndrome</u>.
- 17 (d) The executive commissioner may adopt rules as necessary
- 18 to implement this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
