A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the fees for certain license plates.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 504.003, Transportation Code, is amended
5	by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
6	follows:
7	(c) If <u>a</u> [the] souvenir license plate <u>issued before</u>
8	September 1, 2009, is personalized, the fee for the plate is
9	\$40. Of the fee:
10	(1) \$20 shall be deposited to the credit of the state
11	highway fund;
12	(2) \$10 shall be deposited to the credit of the
13	designated account if the souvenir license plate is a replica of a
14	specialty license plate issued under Subchapter G or I for which the
15	fee is deposited to a designated account other than the state
16	highway fund; and
17	(3) the remainder shall be deposited to the credit of
18	the general revenue fund.
19	(c-1) The fee for a souvenir license plate issued on or
20	after September 1, 2009, is the amount established under Section
21	504.851(c).
22	SECTION 2. Section 504.102, Transportation Code, is amended
23	to read as follows:
24	Sec. 504.102. PERSONALIZATION OF [OTHER] SPECIALTY LICENSE

1 <u>PLATE</u> [PLATES]. Unless expressly prohibited by this chapter or 2 department rule, any specialty license plate issued under this 3 chapter may be personalized. If <u>a</u> [another] specialty license 4 plate is personalized, the fee <u>for personalization of the specialty</u> 5 <u>license plate</u> [established by Section 504.101(c)] shall be added to 6 the fee for issuance of that specialty license plate.

7 SECTION 3. Section 504.601, Transportation Code, is amended 8 to read as follows:

9 Sec. 504.601. GENERAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO [ALL] 10 SPECIALTY LICENSE PLATES FOR GENERAL DISTRIBUTION. (a) Unless 11 expressly provided by this subchapter or department rule:

12 (1) the fee for issuance of a license plate under this13 subchapter is \$30; and

14 (2) of each fee received under this subchapter, the 15 department shall use \$8 to defray its administrative costs in 16 complying with this subchapter.

17 (b) This section does not apply to a specialty license plate 18 marketed and sold by a private vendor at the request of the 19 specialty license plate sponsor under Section 504.6011.

20 SECTION 4. Subchapter G, Chapter 504, Transportation Code, 21 is amended by adding Section 504.6011 to read as follows:

22 <u>Sec. 504.6011. GENERAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO SPECIALTY</u> 23 <u>LICENSE PLATES FOR GENERAL DISTRIBUTION SOLD THROUGH PRIVATE</u> 24 <u>VENDOR. (a) The sponsor of a specialty license plate authorized</u> 25 <u>to be issued under this subchapter before September 1, 2009, may</u> 26 <u>contract with the private vendor authorized under Subchapter J for</u> 27 the marketing and sale of the specialty license plate.

1	(b) The fee for issuance of a specialty license plate
2	described by Subsection (a) is the amount established under Section
3	<u>504.851.</u>
4	(c) Notwithstanding any other law, from each fee received
5	for the issuance of a specialty license plate described by
6	Subsection (a), the department shall:
7	(1) deduct the administrative costs described by
8	Section 504.601(a)(2);
9	(2) deposit to the credit of the account designated by
10	the law authorizing the specialty license plate the portion of the
11	fee for the sale of the plate that the state would ordinarily
12	receive under the contract described by Section 504.851(a); and
13	(3) pay to the private vendor the remainder of the fee.
14	SECTION 5. Section 504.801, Transportation Code, is amended
15	by amending Subsections (d), (e), and (f) and adding Subsection
16	(d-1) to read as follows:
17	(d) The fee for issuance of license plates <u>created</u>
18	[authorized] under this subchapter <u>before September 1, 2009,</u> is \$30
19	unless the department sets a higher fee. This subsection does not
20	apply to a specialty license plate marketed and sold by a private
21	vendor at the request of the specialty license plate sponsor.
22	(d-1) The fee for issuance of license plates created under
23	this subchapter on or after September 1, 2009, is the amount
24	established under Section 504.851.
25	(e) For each fee collected <u>for a license plate issued by the</u>
26	department under this section:
27	(1) \$8 shall be used to reimburse the department for

its administrative costs; and (2) the remainder shall be deposited to the credit of: the specialty license plate fund, which is an (A) account in the general revenue fund, if the sponsor nominated a state agency to receive the funds; or the state highway fund if the sponsor did not (B) nominate a state agency to receive the funds or if there is no sponsor. (f) Subchapter D, Chapter 316, Government Code, and Section 403.095, Government Code, do not apply to fees collected under this subchapter [section]. SECTION 6. Subchapter I, Chapter 504, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 504.802 to read as follows: Sec. 504.802. MARKETING AND SALE BY PRIVATE VENDOR OF SPECIALTY LICENSE PLATES CREATED BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2009. (a) A sponsor of a specialty license plate created under this subchapter before September 1, 2009, may contract with the private vendor authorized under Subchapter J for the marketing and sale of the specialty license plate. (b) The fee for issuance of a specialty license plate described by Subsection (a) is the amount established under Section 504.851(c). (c) Notwithstanding any other law, from each fee received from the issuance of a specialty license plate marketed and sold by the private vendor under this section, the department shall: (1) deduct the administrative costs described by Section 504.801(e)(1);

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1	(2) deposit the portion of the fee for the sale of the
2	plate that the state would ordinarily receive under the contract
3	described by Section 504.851(a) to the credit of:
4	(A) the specialty license plate fund, if the
5	sponsor nominated a state agency to receive the funds; or
6	(B) the general revenue fund, if the sponsor did
7	not nominate a state agency to receive the funds or if there is no
8	sponsor; and
9	(3) pay to the private vendor the remainder of the fee.
10	SECTION 7. Section 504.851, Transportation Code, is amended
11	by amending Subsections (a), (b), and (j) and adding Subsections
12	(a-1), (a-2), and (c-1) to read as follows:
13	(a) The department shall enter into a contract with the
14	private vendor whose proposal is most advantageous to the state, as
15	determined from competitive sealed proposals that satisfy the
16	requirements of this section, for the marketing and sale of:
17	(1) personalized license plates [authorized by
18	Section 504.101]; or
19	(2) with the agreement of the private vendor, other
20	specialty license plates authorized by this <u>chapter</u> [subchapter].
21	(a-1) The department may not issue specialty, personalized,
22	or souvenir license plates with background colors other than white,
23	unless the plates are marketed and sold by the private vendor.
24	(a-2) Specialty license plates authorized for marketing and
25	sale under Subsection (a) must include:
26	(1) specialty license plates created under
27	Subchapters G and I on or after September 1, 2009; and

(2) at the request of the specialty license plate
 2 sponsor, an existing specialty license plate created under
 3 Subchapters G and I before September 1, 2009.

4 (b) <u>The</u> [Instead of the fees established by Section 5 504.101(c), the] commission by rule shall establish fees for the 6 issuance or renewal of personalized license plates that are 7 marketed and sold by the private vendor. Fees must be reasonable 8 and not less than the greater of:

9 (1) the amounts necessary to allow the department to 10 recover all reasonable costs to the department associated with the 11 evaluation of the competitive sealed proposals received by the 12 department and with the implementation and enforcement of the 13 contract, including direct, indirect, and administrative costs; or 14 (2) the amount established by Section <u>504.853(b)</u>

15 [504.101(c)].

16 (c-1) Subsections (b) and (c) do not apply to the sale at 17 auction of a license to display an alphanumeric pattern.

18 From amounts received by the department under the (j) contract described by Subsection (a), the department shall deposit 19 to the credit of the state highway fund an amount sufficient to 20 enable the department to recover its administrative costs for all 21 22 license plates issued under this section, [including] any payments to the vendor under the contract [Subsection (a)], and any other 23 24 amounts allocated by law to the state highway fund [by another law]. 25 To the extent that the disposition of other amounts received by [from] the department is [vendor are] governed by another law, 26 27 those amounts shall be deposited in accordance with the other law.

1 <u>The fee</u>[, and] for each type of license plate <u>issued under this</u> 2 <u>chapter</u> [the amount charged for the license plate] may not be less 3 than the <u>fee</u> [amount] in effect on January 1, 2003. Any additional 4 amount received <u>by</u> [from] the <u>department under the contract</u> 5 [vendor] shall be deposited to the credit of the general revenue 6 fund.

SECTION 8. Subchapter J, Chapter 504, Transportation Code, s is amended by adding Sections 504.853 and 504.854 to read as follows:

10 Sec. 504.853. PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES ISSUED BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2009. (a) A personalized license plate issued before 11 September 1, 2009, may be issued for a subsequent registration 12 13 period only if the applicant submits an application and pays the required fee for the applicable registration period. A person who 14 is issued a personalized license plate has first priority on that 15 license plate for each subsequent registration period for which the 16 person submits a new application for that plate. 17

18 (b) The fee for issuance of a personalized license plate 19 issued before September 1, 2009, is \$40, unless the director adopts 20 by rule a higher fee.

21 (c) A person who is issued a personalized license plate by 22 the department before September 1, 2009, may:

23 (1) submit an application for the plate under
24 Subsection (a) and pay the required fee for each subsequent
25 registration period under Subsection (b); or

26 (2) purchase through the private vendor a license to 27 display the alphanumeric pattern on a license plate for any term

1	allowed by law.
2	(d) The department may not issue a replacement set of
3	personalized license plates to the same person before the sixth
4	anniversary of the date of issuance unless the applicant for
5	issuance of replacement plates pays an additional fee of \$30.
6	(e) Of each fee collected by the department under this
7	section:
8	(1) \$1.25 shall be used to defray the cost of
9	administering this section; and
10	(2) the remainder shall be deposited to the credit of
11	the general revenue fund.
12	Sec. 504.854. AUCTION. (a) The private vendor may sell at
13	auction a license to display a unique alphanumeric pattern on a
14	license plate.
15	(b) Only a license to display an alphanumeric pattern
16	purchased under this section or a license to display an
17	alphanumeric pattern sold by the private vendor under Section
18	504.853 may be transferred to another person. The transferee is
19	entitled to the same rights and privileges as the transferor.
20	(c) The transferee shall file a form prescribed by the
21	department to notify the department of the transfer. The
22	department may set a fee to be paid by the transferee to the
23	department for the transfer.
24	SECTION 9. The following provisions of the Transportation
25	Code are repealed:
26	(1) Section 504.101; and
27	(2) Subsection (m), Section 504.851.

1 SECTION 10. The changes in law made by this Act do not 2 require the rebidding of a contract that is in effect on the 3 effective date of this Act.

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4 SECTION 11. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
