## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 157.318, Family Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (a) <u>Subject to Subsection (d)</u>, <u>a</u> [A] lien is effective until
- 8 all current support and child support arrearages, including
- 9 interest, any costs and reasonable attorney's fees, and any Title
- 10 IV-D service fees authorized under Section 231.103 for which the
- 11 obligor is responsible, have been paid or the lien is otherwise
- 12 released as provided by this subchapter.
- 13 (d) A lien is effective with respect to real property until
- 14 the 10th anniversary of the date on which the lien notice was filed
- 15 with the county clerk. A lien subject to the limitation prescribed
- 16 by this subsection may be renewed for subsequent 10-year periods by
- 17 filing, before the expiration of the preceding 10-year period, a
- 18 renewed lien notice in the same manner as the original lien notice.
- 19 A renewed lien notice relates back to the date the original lien
- 20 <u>notice was filed.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 231.002(h), Family Code, is repealed.
- 22 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 23 157.318, Family Code, apply only to a child support lien notice that
- 24 is filed on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
