- 10 unless the original restriction instrument expressly prohibits the
- 11 procedure from being used for successive extensions.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subdivision (4), Section 210.001, Property Code,
- 13 is amended to read as follows:
- 14 (4) "Residential real estate subdivision" or
- 15 "subdivision" has the meaning assigned by Section 201.003, except
- 16 that in a county described by Section 210.002(1) a subdivision that
- 17 is a gated community with private streets need not be located in a
- 18 city, town, or village or within the extraterritorial jurisdiction
- 19 of a city, town, or village.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
