4	SECTION 1. Article 20.02, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
5	amended by amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsections (i) and
6	(j) to read as follows:
7	(h) A subpoena or summons relating to a grand jury
8	proceeding or investigation must be kept secret to the extent and
9	for as long as necessary to prevent the unauthorized disclosure of a
10	matter before the grand jury. This subsection may not be construed
11	to limit a disclosure permitted by Subsection (c), (d), $[er]$ (e), or
12	<u>(i)</u> .
13	(i) Subsection (h) does not apply to:
14	(1) a disclosure made in the course of an
15	attorney-client relationship; or
16	(2) a news media employee who is engaging in a
17	<pre>news-gathering activity.</pre>
18	(j) In this section, "news media" means:
19	(1) a radio or television station that holds a license
20	issued by the Federal Communications Commission;
21	(2) a newspaper that is qualified under Section
22	2051.044, Government Code, to publish legal notices or is a free
23	newspaper of general circulation and that is published at least
24	once a week and available and of interest to the general public in

- 1 connection with the dissemination of news; or
- 2 (3) a magazine that appears at a regular interval,
- 3 that contains stories, articles, and essays by various writers, and
- 4 that is of interest to the general public in connection with the
- 5 <u>dissemination of news or public affairs.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
