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1 commissioners court of the county, including a program established 2 under Article 56.04(f), Code of Criminal Procedure, that offers 3 psychological counseling to jurors in criminal cases involving 4 graphic evidence or testimony.

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5 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 6 to donations from jurors appearing in response to a summons issued 7 on or after the effective date of this Act.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
