4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:	

- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 38, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 38.075 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 38.075. CORROBORATION OF CERTAIN TESTIMONY REQUIRED.
- 8 (a) A defendant may not be convicted of an offense on the testimony
- 9 of a person to whom the defendant made a statement against the
- 10 <u>defendant's interest during a time when the person was imprisoned</u>
- 11 or confined in the same correctional facility as the defendant
- 12 unless the testimony is corroborated by other evidence tending to
- 13 connect the defendant with the offense committed. In this
- 14 subsection, "correctional facility" has the meaning assigned by
- 15 Section 1.07, Penal Code.
- 16 (b) Corroboration is not sufficient for the purposes of this
- 17 article if the corroboration only shows that the offense was
- 18 committed.

- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to any
- 20 case in which a judgment has not been entered before the effective
- 21 date of this Act. A case in which a judgment has been entered before
- 22 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when
- 23 the judgment was entered, and the former law is continued in effect
- 24 for that purpose.
