6	SECTION 1. Section 191.097, Natural Resources Code, is
7	amended by adding Subsection(c) to read as follows:
8	(c) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the committee shall
9	remove from designation as a landmark a county courthouse square,
10	county courthouse, or other real property in a county courthouse
11	square if:
12	(1) the commissioners court adopts and submits to the
13	committee a resolution seeking the removal from designation as a
14	landmark the county courthouse square, county courthouse, or other
15	real property in a county courthouse square; and
16	(2) the county in which the county courthouse square,
17	county courthouse, or other real property in the county courthouse
18	square is located has not received any funds from the committee for
19	the preservation, restoration or modification of the county
20	courthouse square, county courthouse, or other real property.
21	(d) The committee may not designate as a landmark a county
22	courthouse square, county courthouse, or other real property in a
23	county courthouse square after removal of a landmark designation
24	under Subsection (c) unless the county commissioners court adopts a

## 1 resolution consenting to the designation.

- 2 SECTION 2. This act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
