A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the governing body of an independent organization for a 3 power region.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 39.151, Utilities Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (g) and adding new Subsections (g-2) and (g-3) 7 to read as follows:

certification 8 (q) Τо maintain as an independent organization under this section, an organization's governing body 9 must be composed of persons specified by this section and selected 10 in accordance with formal bylaws or protocols of the organization. 11 12 The bylaws or protocols must be approved by the commission and must 13 reflect the input of the commission and the commission may modify The bylaws must [specify the process by which 14 the bylaws. 15 appropriate stakeholders elect members and, for unaffiliated members, prescribe professional qualifications for unaffiliated 16 members. The bylaws must require the use of a professional search 17 firm to identify candidates for membership of unaffiliated members. 18 The process must allow for commission input in identifying 19 candidates. The governing body must be composed of: 20

21 (1) the chairman of the commission as an ex officio 22 nonvoting member;

(2) the counselor as an ex officio voting member
representing residential and small commercial consumer interests;

No. 1700 the chief executive officer of the independent 1 (3) 2 organization as an ex officio voting member; (4) [six market participants elected by their 3 4 respective market segments to serve one year terms, with: 5 [(A) one representing independent generators; [(B) one representing investor owned utilities; 6 7 [(C) one representing power marketers; [(D) one representing retail electric provider; 8 9 [(E) one representing municipally owned 10 utilities; and 11 [(F) one representing electric cooperatives; [(5) one member representing industrial consumer 12 interests and elected by the industrial consumer market segment to 13 14 serve a one year term; 15 [(6) one member <u>representing large</u> -commercial 16 consumer interests selected in accordance with the bylaws the serve 17 a one year term; and (7)] eight [five] members unaffiliated with any market 18 segment and selected by the other members of the governing body to 19 serve three-year terms. Unaffiliated directors may not serve more 20 than three consecutive terms. 21 (h) The commission may remove an unaffiliated member for 22 failing to impartially and adequately discharge the duties of the 23 24 member. 25 (i) The chairman of the commission and the executive director of the commission, or the executive director's designee, 26 shall be permitted to attend any executive session of the governing 27
