- SECTION 4. Section 702.304(a), Occupations Code, is amended

3	(3) "IF THE HEALTH SPA GOES OUT OF BUSINESS AND DOES

5	ARE ENROLLED OR IF THE HEALTH SPA MOVES MORE THAN 10 MILES FROM THE
6	FACILITY IN WHICH YOU ARE ENROLLED, YOU MAY:
7	(A) CANCEL THIS CONTRACT BY MAILING BY CERTIFIED
8	MAIL A WRITTEN NOTICE STATING YOUR DESIRE TO CANCEL THIS CONTRACT,

15	A CLAIM AGAINST THE SECURITY SEND A COPY OF YOUR CONTRACT TOGETHER

17	OF STATE. [THE WRITTEN NOTICE MUST BE MAILED BY CERTIFIED MAIL TO

23	(4) "IF YOU DIE OR BECOME TOTALLY AND PERMANENTLY
24	DISABLED AFTER THE DATE THIS CONTRACT TAKES EFFECT, YOU OR YOUR
25	ESTATE MAY CANCEL THIS CONTRACT AND RECEIVE A PARTIAL REFUND OF YOUR
26	UNUSED MEMBERSHIP FEE BY MAILING A NOTICE TO THE HEALTH SPA STATING
27	YOUR DESIRE TO CANCEL THIS CONTRACT. THE HEALTH SPA MAY REQUIRE

1 FOLLOWING ADDRESS:

- 1 PROOF OF DISABILITY OR DEATH. THE WRITTEN NOTICE MUST BE MAILED BY
- 2 CERTIFIED MAIL TO THE FOLLOWING ADDRESS:

- 4 SECTION 5. Section 702.452(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) At least 30 days before the date a health spa is
- 7 scheduled to close or relocate, the certificate holder shall
- 8 contemporaneously:
- 9 (1) post, inside and outside each entrance to the
- 10 health spa, a notice stating:
- 11 (A) the date the health spa is scheduled to close
- 12 or relocate;
- 13 (B) that a member of the health spa may, not later
- 14 than the 90th day after the date the notice is first posted [health
- 15 spa closes or relocates], file with the secretary of state a claim
- 16 to recover actual financial loss suffered by the member as a result
- 17 of the health spa closing; and
- 18 (C) the procedures for perfecting a security
- 19 claim; and
- 20 (2) notify the secretary of state in writing of the
- 21 health spa closing or relocation and the date that the notice was
- 22 first posted.
- SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections
- 24 702.251, 702.304(a), and 702.452(a), Occupations Code, apply only
- 25 to a contract that is entered into on or after the effective date of
- 26 this Act. A contract entered into before the effective date of this
- 27 Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that date,

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- 1 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
