A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the requirements for a smoke detector in multifamily 3 residential units. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 92.254(a), Property Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 (a) A smoke detector must be: 7 (1) designed to detect both the visible and invisible 8 9 products of combustion; (2) designed with an alarm that is audible to a person 10 11 with a normal range of hearing and is capable of alerting a 12 hearing-impaired person in the bedrooms it serves; 13 (3) powered by battery, alternating current, or other 14 power source as required by local ordinance; (4) tested and listed for use as a smoke detector by 15 Underwriters Laboratories, Inc., Factory Mutual 16 Research Corporation, or United States Testing Company, Inc.; and 17 18 (5) in good working order. SECTION 2. Section 92.254(a), Property Code, as amended by 19 this Act, applies only to a smoke detector installed under 20 21 Subchapter F, Chapter 92, Property Code, on or after September 1, 22 2009. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 23

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
