A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to physical examination requirements for participation in
- 3 extracurricular athletic activities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 33.093 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 33.093. PHYSICAL EXAMINATION REQUIRED FOR
- 8 PARTICIPATION IN EXTRACURRICULAR ATHLETIC ACTIVITY. (a) In this
- 9 section:
- 10 (1) "Advanced practice nurse" means a registered nurse
- 11 approved by the Texas Board of Nursing to practice as an advanced
- 12 practice nurse as provided by Section 301.152, Occupations Code.
- 13 (2) "Physician" means a physician licensed under
- 14 Subtitle B, Title 3, Occupations Code.
- 15 (3) "Physician assistant" means a person who is
- 16 licensed under Chapter 204, Occupations Code.
- 17 (b) A student may not participate in an extracurricular
- 18 athletic activity, including an athletic practice, scrimmage,
- 19 game, or match, sponsored or sanctioned by the University
- 20 Interscholastic League unless the student has submitted to the
- 21 school district the student attends a completed form indicating
- 22 that the student has received a physical examination conducted by a
- 23 physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice nurse. The
- 24 form must:

- 1 (1) be signed by the physician, physician assistant,
- 2 or advanced practice nurse; and
- 3 (2) include a statement that, based on the
- 4 examination, the physician, physician assistant, or advanced
- 5 practice nurse has determined that the student does not have a
- 6 medical condition that would make participation in the athletic
- 7 activity hazardous for the student.
- 8 <u>(c) The University Interscholastic League shall adopt rules</u>
- 9 to administer this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 11 school year.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
