## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 28.009, Education Code,
6	is amended to read as follows:
7	(b) The agency shall coordinate with the Texas Higher
8	Education Coordinating Board as necessary in administering this
9	section. The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary concerning
10	the duties under this section of a school district. The Texas
11	Higher Education Coordinating Board may adopt rules as necessary
12	concerning the duties under this section of a public institution of
13	higher education.
14	SECTION 2. Effective September 1, 2009, Subsection (c),
15	Section 28.009, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
16	(c) Each school district shall annually report to the
17	agency:
18	(1) the number of district students, including career
19	and technical students, who have participated in the program [and
20	<pre>earned college credit]; and</pre>
21	(2) the [ <del>cumulative number of</del> ] courses in which
22	participating district students [have enrolled and college credit
23	hours the students] have earned high school credit under this

SECTION 3. Effective September 1, 2011, Subsection (c),
Section 28.009, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

3 (c) <u>The commissioner and the Texas Higher Education</u> 4 <u>Coordinating Board shall share data as necessary to enable school</u> 5 <u>districts to comply with this subsection.</u> Each school district 6 shall annually report to the agency:

7 (1) the number of district students, including career 8 and technical students, who have participated in the program and 9 earned college credit; and

10 (2) the cumulative number of courses in which 11 participating district students have enrolled and college credit 12 hours the students have earned.

SECTION 4. Effective September 1, 2011, Section 28.009, La Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

16 (c-1) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall 17 collect student course credit data from public institutions of 18 higher education as necessary for purposes of Subsection (c).

19 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
