The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary concerning the duties under this section of a school district. The Texas Higher 10 Education Coordinating Board may adopt rules as necessary 11 12 concerning the duties under this section of a public institution of higher education. 13 14 (c) Each school district shall annually report to the 15 agency: (1) the number of district students, including career 16 and technical students, who have participated in the program and 17 earned college credit; and 18 (2) the cumulative number of 19 courses in which participating district students have [enrolled and college credit 20 21 hours the students have] earned high school credit under this 22 section. 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24
