1	AN ACT
2	relating to minimum training standards for employees of certain
3	child-care facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 42.0421, Human Resources
6	Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The minimum training standards prescribed by the
8	department under Section 42.042(p) for an employee of a day-care
9	center or group day-care home must include:
10	(1) 16 [eight] hours of initial training that must be
11	completed not later than the 90th day after the employee's first day
12	of employment for an employee of a day-care center who has no
13	previous training or <u>less than two years of</u> employment experience
14	in a regulated child-care facility, eight hours of which must [to]
15	be completed before the employee is given responsibility for a
16	group of children;
17	(2) 17 [15] hours of annual training for each employee
18	of a day-care center or group day-care home, excluding the
19	director, which must include at least six hours of training in one
20	or more of the following areas:
21	(A) child growth and development;
22	(B) guidance and discipline;
23	(C) age-appropriate curriculum; and
24	(D) teacher-child interaction; and

- 1 (3) 30 [20] hours of annual training for each director
- 2 of a day-care center or group day-care home, which must include at
- 3 least six hours of training in one or more of the following areas:
- 4 (A) child growth and development;
- 5 (B) guidance and discipline;
- 6 (C) age-appropriate curriculum; and
- 7 (D) teacher-child interaction.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 42.0426, Human Resources Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 10 (c) Not later than the seventh day after the date an
- 11 employee begins employment at a child-care facility, the employee
- 12 must complete an orientation to the facility.
- 13 SECTION 3. (a) Subdivision (1), Subsection (a), Section
- 14 42.0421, Human Resources Code, as amended by this Act, and
- 15 Subsection (c), Section 42.0426, Human Resources Code, as added by
- 16 this Act, apply only to an employee who is initially employed by a
- 17 child-care facility on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 18 employee who is initially employed by a child-care facility before
- 19 that date is subject to the law in effect immediately before the
- 20 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 21 effect for that purpose.
- (b) Subdivisions (2) and (3), Subsection (a), Section
- 23 42.0421, Human Resources Code, as amended by this Act, apply to an
- 24 employee or director of a child-care facility regardless of the
- 25 date the person began employment with or service as director of the
- 26 child-care facility.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
