- 2 relating to offenses involving boating safety and the disposition
- 3 of fines for certain water safety offenses.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 31.099, Parks and
- 6 Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 31.099. PROHIBITION ON CIRCULAR COURSE AROUND
- 8 INDIVIDUALS ENGAGED IN WATER ACTIVITIES [FISHERMAN OR SWIMMER].
- 9 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 31.099, Parks and
- 10 Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) No person may operate a motorboat in a circular course
- 12 around:
- 13 (1) any other boat any occupant of which is engaged in
- 14 fishing, waterskiing, or a similar activity; or
- 15 (2) [around] any person swimming.
- SECTION 3. Subsections (a) and (c), Section 31.106, Parks
- 17 and Wildlife Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) No person shall operate a personal watercraft in the
- 19 following manner or under the following circumstances:
- 20 (1) unless each person riding on or towed behind the
- 21 vessel is wearing a U.S. Coast Guard approved Type I, II, III, or V
- 22 personal flotation device;
- 23 (2) if the vessel is equipped by the manufacturer with
- 24 a lanyard type engine cutoff switch, unless such lanyard is

- 1 attached to the person, clothing, or personal flotation device of
- 2 the operator as appropriate for the vessel involved;
- 3 (3) during the period between sunset and sunrise;
- 4 (4) within $\underline{100}$ [50] feet of any other vessel, person,
- 5 stationary platform or other object, or shore, except at headway
- 6 speed;
- 7 (5) if the operator is under 16 years of age, unless
- 8 the operator:
- 9 (A) is accompanied by a person at least 18 years
- 10 of age; or
- 11 (B) is at least 13 years of age and has
- 12 successfully completed a boating safety course prescribed and
- 13 approved by the department;
- 14 (6) if the personal watercraft is a motorboat, within
- 15 any area prohibited for operation of a motorboat by state law or
- 16 local rule or regulation;
- 17 (7) while towing water skis, an aquaplane, a
- 18 surfboard, a tube, or any other similar device, unless the towing
- 19 vessel is designed to carry on board a minimum of two persons;
- 20 (8) by jumping the wake of another vessel recklessly
- 21 or unnecessarily close to that vessel; or
- 22 (9) in a manner that requires the operator to swerve at
- 23 the last possible moment to avoid collision.
- (c) Subsection (a)(4) of this section does not prohibit the
- 25 operation of personal watercraft on bodies of water less than 200
- 26 $\left[\frac{100}{100}\right]$ feet in width.
- 27 SECTION 4. Section 31.107, Parks and Wildlife Code, is

- 1 amended to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 31.107. OPERATION OF MOTORBOAT. (a) No person may
- 3 operate a motorboat of over 15 horsepower on the public waters of
- 4 this state unless the person is 16 years of age or older or:
- 5 (1) is accompanied by a person 18 $\left[\frac{(18)}{(18)}\right]$ years of age
- 6 or older; or
- 7 (2) is at least 13 years of age and has successfully
- 8 passed a boating safety course prescribed and approved by the
- 9 department.
- 10 (b) No person may operate a motorboat within 100 feet of the
- 11 shore, any other vessel, a person, or a stationary platform or other
- 12 object unless:
- 13 (1) the boat's speed does not exceed headway speed;
- 14 (2) the boat is in a no-wake zone; or
- 15 (3) a distance of at least 100 feet is not possible.
- SECTION 5. Subsection (c), Section 31.128, Parks and
- 17 Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 18 (c) In court cases filed as the result of an arrest by a
- 19 marine safety enforcement officer other than a game warden, the
- 20 amount of the fine shall be remitted to the entity employing the
- 21 marine safety enforcement officer [to be remitted to the game,
- 22 fish, and water safety account shall be 60 percent of the fine].
- 23 All costs of the court shall be retained by the court having
- 24 jurisdiction of the offense and deposited as other fees in the
- 25 proper county fund.
- SECTION 6. Subsection (d), Section 31.128, Parks and
- 27 Wildlife Code, is repealed.

- 1 SECTION 7. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 2 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 3 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 4 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 5 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 6 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 7 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that
- 8 date.
- 9 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect July 1, 2009, if it
- 10 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 11 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 12 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
- 13 date, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
