## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 361.8065(a), Health and Safety Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Before the executive director may issue a municipal
- 8 setting designation certificate under Section 361.807, the
- 9 applicant must provide documentation, which may be in the form of an
- 10 affidavit of the applicant or the applicant's representative, of
- 11 the following:
- 12 (1) that <u>no resolution opposing</u> the application <u>has</u>
- 13 <u>been</u> [is supported by a resolution] adopted by:
- 14 (A) the city council of any [each] municipality
- 15 described by Section 361.805(a)(1)(B) or (C); or [and]
- 16 (B) the governing body of any [each] retail
- 17 public utility described by Section 361.805(a)(3); and
- 18 (2) that the property for which designation is sought
- 19 is:

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- 20 (A) subject to an ordinance that prohibits the
- 21 use of designated groundwater from beneath the property as potable
- 22 water and that appropriately restricts other uses of and contact
- 23 with that groundwater; or
- 24 (B) subject to a restrictive covenant

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- 1 enforceable by the municipality in which the property for which the
- 2 designation is sought is located that prohibits the use of
- 3 designated groundwater from beneath the property as potable water
- 4 and appropriately restricts other uses of and contact with that
- 5 groundwater.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 361.807(c), Health and Safety Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (c) If the executive director determines that an applicant
- 9 has submitted a complete application except that an ordinance or
- 10 restrictive covenant and any required <u>documentation</u> [resolutions]
- 11 satisfying the requirements described in Section 361.8065 have not
- 12 been submitted, the executive director shall issue a letter to the
- 13 applicant listed in Subsection (a) stating that a municipal setting
- 14 designation will be certified on submission of a copy of the
- 15 ordinance or restrictive covenant and any required <u>documentation</u>
- 16 [resolutions] satisfying the requirements described in Section
- 17 361.8065. On submission of the ordinance or restrictive covenant
- 18 and any required documentation [resolutions] satisfying the
- 19 requirements described in Section 361.8065, the executive director
- 20 shall issue a municipal setting designation certificate in
- 21 accordance with Subsections (a) and (b).
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
