A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- relating to the award of stipends to nationally certified classroom 2
- 3 teachers under the educator excellence awards program.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 21.705, Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:
- Sec. 21.705. AWARD PAYMENTS. A school district must use at 7
- least 60 percent of grant funds awarded to the district under this 8
- 9 subchapter to directly award classroom teachers who effectively
- improve student achievement as determined by meaningful, objective 10
- 11 measures. The remaining funds must be used only to:
- 12 (1) provide stipends to effective mentors or teacher
- 13 coaches;

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- 14 (2) provide stipends to classroom teachers who are
- certified in a subject that is designated by the commissioner as 15
- 16 commonly experiencing a critical shortage of teachers;
- (3) provide stipends to classroom teachers who are 17
- certified under Subchapter B in the main subject area in which they 18
- 19 teach;
- 20 (4) provide stipends to classroom teachers with proven
- 21 records of success for improving student performance who are
- assigned to campuses at which the district has experienced 22
- 23 difficulty assigning or retaining teachers;
- 24 (5) provide stipends to classroom teachers who hold

- 1 postgraduate degrees;
- 2 (6) provide stipends to classroom teachers who have
- 3 obtained national board certification through the National Board
- 4 for Professional Teaching Standards;
- 5 (7) provide awards to principals who effectively
- 6 increase student performance as determined by objective measures;
- 7 (8) [(7)] provide awards to other campus employees who
- 8 demonstrate excellence; or
- 9 (9) $[\frac{(8)}{(8)}]$ implement the components of a Teacher
- 10 Advancement Program (TAP), including:
- 11 (A) an instructionally focused accountability
- 12 system; and
- 13 (B) the adjustment of teaching schedules to
- 14 permit ongoing applied professional growth.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 16 school year.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
