- SECTION 2. Subsection (e), Section 254.154, Election Code,
- 18 is amended to read as follows:
- 19 (e) In addition to other required reports, the campaign

- 21 and an ensuing] runoff election shall file one report for the runoff
- 22 election. The runoff election report must be received by the

- 1 election day. The report covers the period beginning the ninth day

- 4 SECTION 3. Subsection (e), Section 254.124, and Subsection
- 5 (e), Section 254.154, Election Code, as amended by this Act, apply
- 6 only to a runoff election that follows an election held on or after
- 7 September 1, 2009.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
