1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subsection (m), Section 49.002, Health and
- 5 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (m) In consultation with the Texas Organ, Tissue, and Eye
- 7 Donor Council, the department shall [may] implement a training
- 8 program for all appropriate Department of Public Safety and Texas
- 9 Department of Transportation employees on the benefits of organ,
- 10 tissue, and eye donation and the procedures for individuals to be
- 11 added to the statewide Internet-based registry of organ, tissue,
- 12 and eye donors. Department of Public Safety and Texas Department of
- 13 Transportation employees are not required to answer customer
- 14 questions about donation or transplantation. The Department of
- 15 Public Safety training under this section must include training on
- 16 asking the appropriate question under Section 521.401(c)(1)(B).
- 17 The department, with expert council input and support, shall
- 18 implement the training program [before the date that the statewide
- 19 Internet-based registry is operational] and [shall] conduct the
- 20 training on an ongoing basis for new employees.
- 21 SECTION 2. Subsection (d), Section 692.003, Health and
- 22 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 23 (d) A gift made by a document other than a will is effective
- 24 on the death of the donor. The document may be a card designed to be

- 1 carried by the donor or another record signed by the donor or other
 2 person making the gift. A statement or symbol in an online donor
- 3 registry and authorized by the donor indicating the donor has made
- 4 an anatomical gift may also serve as a document making a gift. To be
- 5 effective, the document must be signed by the donor in the presence
- 6 of two witnesses except as otherwise provided by Subchapter Q,
- 7 Chapter 521, Transportation Code, this subsection, or other law.
- 8 If the donor cannot sign the document, a person may sign the
- 9 document for the donor at the donor's direction and in the presence
- 10 of the donor and two witnesses. The witnesses to the signing of a
- 11 document under this subsection must sign the document in the
- 12 presence of the donor. Delivery of the document during the donor's
- 13 lifetime is not necessary to make the gift valid. An online
- 14 donation registration does not require the consent of another
- 15 <u>person or require two witnesses.</u> The online registration
- 16 constitutes a legal document under this chapter and remains binding
- 17 <u>after the donor's death.</u>
- SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
- 19 is amended by adding Section 502.189 to read as follows:
- Sec. 502.189. DONOR REGISTRY INFORMATION. (a) The
- 21 department, with expert input and support from the Texas Organ,
- 22 <u>Tissue, and Eye Donor Council, sha</u>ll:
- 23 (1) add a link from the department's Internet website
- 24 to the Donor Education, Awareness, and Registry Program of Texas
- 25 <u>established under Chapter 49, Health and Safety Code; and</u>
- 26 (2) provide a method to distribute donor registry
- 27 information to interested individuals in each office authorized to

- 1 <u>issue motor vehicle registrations.</u>
- 2 (b) The department shall make available for distribution to
- 3 each office authorized to issue motor vehicle registrations Donate
- 4 Life brochures that provide basic donor information in English and
- 5 Spanish and a contact phone number and e-mail address. The
- 6 department shall ensure that the question provided in Section
- 7 521.401(c)(1)(B) and information on the donor registry Internet
- 8 website is included with registration renewal notices.
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 521.401, Transportation Code, is amended
- 10 by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 (c) Donor <u>registry information</u> [cards] shall be provided to
- 13 the department and the Texas Department of Transportation by
- 14 qualified organ or tissue procurement organizations or eye banks,
- 15 as those terms are defined in Section 692.002, Health and Safety
- 16 Code, or by the Donor Education, Awareness, and Registry Program of
- 17 Texas established under Chapter 49, Health and Safety Code. The
- 18 department, with expert input and support from the Texas Organ,
- 19 <u>Tissue, and Eye Donor Council,</u> shall:
- 20 (1) provide to each applicant for the issuance of an
- 21 original, renewal, corrected, or duplicate driver's license or
- 22 personal identification certificate who applies in person, by mail,
- 23 over the Internet, or by other electronic means:
- 24 (A) the opportunity to indicate on the person's
- 25 driver's license or personal identification certificate that the
- 26 person is willing to make an anatomical gift, in the event of death,
- 27 in accordance with Section 692.003, Health and Safety Code; and

- 1 an opportunity for the person to consent in (B) 2 writing to the department's provision of the person's name, date of birth, driver's license number, most recent address, and other 3 4 information needed for identification purposes at the time of donation to the organization selected by the commissioner of state 5 health services under Chapter 49, Health and Safety Code, for 6 7 inclusion in the statewide Internet-based registry of organ, tissue, and eye donors and for release to qualified organ, tissue, 8 9 and eye bank organizations by specifically asking each applicant only the question, "Would you like to register as an organ donor?"; 10 11 and
- (2) provide a means to distribute donor <u>registry</u>

 13 <u>information</u> [cards] to interested individuals in each office

 14 authorized to issue driver's licenses or personal identification

 15 certificates.
- 16 (e) The department shall distribute at all field offices
 17 Donate Life brochures that provide basic donation information in
 18 English and Spanish and include a contact phone number and e-mail
 19 address. The department shall include the question required under
 20 Subsection (c)(1)(B) and information on the donor registry Internet
 21 website in renewal notices.
- 22 SECTION 5. Not later than January 1, 2010:
- (1) the Department of State Health Services shall implement the training program required under Subsection (m), Section 49.002, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act;
- 26 (2) the Department of Public Safety of the State of 27 Texas shall implement Section 521.401, Transportation Code, as

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- 1 amended by this Act; and
- 2 (3) the Texas Department of Transportation shall
- 3 implement Section 502.189, Transportation Code, as added by this
- 4 Act.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
