## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the 39th Judicial District Juvenile Board.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 152.1101, Human Resources Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 152.1101. HASKELL COUNTY. (a) Haskell County is
7	included in the 39th Judicial District Juvenile Board. The
8	juvenile board [of Haskell County] is composed of:
9	(1) the county judge of Haskell County;
10	(2) the county judge of Kent County;
11	(3) the county judge of Stonewall County;
12	(4) the county judge of Throckmorton County; and
13	(5) the 39th Judicial District judge [, the district
14	judges in Haskell County, and the judge of any statutory court
15	designated as a juvenile court].
16	(b) The juvenile court judge may appoint two public members
17	to serve on the board for a term set by the judge.
18	$\underline{\text{(c)}}$ [ $\frac{\text{(b)}}{\text{)}}$ ] The juvenile board shall elect one of its members
19	as chairman at the beginning of each year.
20	$\underline{(d)}$ [ $\frac{(c)}{(c)}$ ] The commissioners court of each county shall pay
21	the county judge of that county and the 39th Judicial District judge
22	additional [judges on the board an] annual compensation of [salary
23	set by the commissioners court at] not more than \$6,000 [\$1,200],
24	payable in equal monthly installments from the general fund or any

- 1 other available fund of the county, for the added duties imposed on
- 2 the judges under this section. The public members serve without
- 3 compensation.
- 4 [(d) The chief juvenile probation officer may set the
- 5 salaries and allowances of juvenile probation personnel with the
- 6 approval of the board.
- 7 (e) <u>If approved by the juvenile board, the commissioners</u>
- 8 court shall reimburse the juvenile court judge for the judge's
- 9 <u>actual and necessary expenses incurred in attending seminars and</u>
- 10 other educational or instructional meetings related to juvenile
- 11 problems. The counties shall prorate the expenses allowed for the
- 12 members of the juvenile board and for the juvenile court judge.
- 13 (f) The commissioners court of each county shall jointly
- 14 provide the necessary funds to pay the salaries of the juvenile
- 15 probation personnel in the amount set by the juvenile board.
- 16 (g) The commissioners court of each county shall jointly pay
- 17 the expenses of the juvenile probation officers that are certified
- 18 as necessary by the juvenile board chairman from the general fund
- 19 and in the amount set by the juvenile board.
- 20 (h) Sections 152.0004 and [Section] 152.0005(b) do [does]
- 21 not apply to the juvenile board [of Haskell County].
- SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 152, Human Resources Code,
- 23 is amended by adding Section 152.1381 to read as follows:
- Sec. 152.1381. KENT COUNTY. (a) Kent County is included
- 25 in the 39th Judicial District Juvenile Board.
- 26 (b) Section 152.1101 applies to the 39th Judicial District
- 27 Juvenile Board.

- 1 SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 152, Human Resources Code,
- 2 is amended by adding Section 152.2231 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 152.2231. STONEWALL COUNTY. (a) Stonewall County is
- 4 <u>included in the 39th Judicial District Juvenile Board.</u>
- 5 (b) Section 152.1101 applies to the 39th Judicial District
- 6 Juvenile Board.
- 7 SECTION 4. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 152.2301, Human
- 8 Resources Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) Throckmorton County is included in the 39th Judicial
- 10 District Juvenile Board. [The juvenile board of Throckmorton
- 11 County is composed of the county judge, the district judges in
- 12 Throckmorton County, and the judge of each statutory court
- 13 designated as a juvenile court in the county. The juvenile court
- 14 judge may appoint two public members to serve on the board for a
- 15 period determined by the juvenile court judge.
- 16 (b) <u>Section 152.1101 applies to the 39th Judicial District</u>
- 17 <u>Juvenile Board.</u> [The juvenile board shall elect one of its members
- 18 as chairman at the beginning of each year.
- 19 SECTION 5. Subsections (c), (d), and (e), Section 152.2301,
- 20 Human Resources Code, are repealed.
- 21 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
