1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the 39th Judicial District Juvenile Board.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Section 152.1101, Human Resources Code, is
1-11 amended to read as follows:

1-12 Sec. 152.1101. HASKELL COUNTY. (a) Haskell County is
1-13 included in the 39th Judicial District Juvenile Board. The
1-14 juvenile board [of Haskell County] is composed of:

1-15 (1) the county judge of Haskell County;

1-16 (2) the county judge of Kent County;

1-17 (3) the county judge of Stonewall County;

1-18 (4) the county judge of Throckmorton County; and

1-19 (5) the 39th Judicial District judge~~[, the district~~
1-20 ~~judges in Haskell County, and the judge of any statutory court~~
1-21 ~~designated as a juvenile court].~~

1-22 (b) The juvenile court judge may appoint two public members
1-23 to serve on the board for a term set by the judge.

1-24 (c) ~~[(b)]~~ The juvenile board shall elect one of its members
1-25 as chairman at the beginning of each year.

1-26 (d) ~~[(c)]~~ The commissioners court of each county shall pay
1-27 the county judge of that county and the 39th Judicial District judge
1-28 additional [judges on the board an] annual compensation of [salary
1-29 set by the commissioners court at] not more than \$6,000 [\$1,200],
1-30 payable in equal monthly installments from the general fund or any
1-31 other available fund of the county, for the added duties imposed on
1-32 the judges under this section. The public members serve without
1-33 compensation.

1-34 ~~[(d) The chief juvenile probation officer may set the~~
1-35 ~~salaries and allowances of juvenile probation personnel with the~~
1-36 ~~approval of the board.]~~

1-37 (e) If approved by the juvenile board, the commissioners
1-38 court shall reimburse the juvenile court judge for the judge's
1-39 actual and necessary expenses incurred in attending seminars and
1-40 other educational or instructional meetings related to juvenile
1-41 problems. The counties shall prorate the expenses allowed for the
1-42 members of the juvenile board and for the juvenile court judge.

1-43 (f) The commissioners court of each county shall jointly
1-44 provide the necessary funds to pay the salaries of the juvenile
1-45 probation personnel in the amount set by the juvenile board.

1-46 (g) The commissioners court of each county shall jointly pay
1-47 the expenses of the juvenile probation officers that are certified
1-48 as necessary by the juvenile board chairman from the general fund
1-49 and in the amount set by the juvenile board.

1-50 (h) Sections 152.0004 and [Section] 152.0005(b) do [does]
1-51 not apply to the juvenile board [of Haskell County].

1-52 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 152, Human Resources Code,
1-53 is amended by adding Section 152.1381 to read as follows:

1-54 Sec. 152.1381. KENT COUNTY. (a) Kent County is included
1-55 in the 39th Judicial District Juvenile Board.

1-56 (b) Section 152.1101 applies to the 39th Judicial District
1-57 Juvenile Board.

1-58 SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 152, Human Resources Code,
1-59 is amended by adding Section 152.2231 to read as follows:

1-60 Sec. 152.2231. STONEWALL COUNTY. (a) Stonewall County is
1-61 included in the 39th Judicial District Juvenile Board.

1-62 (b) Section 152.1101 applies to the 39th Judicial District
1-63 Juvenile Board.

1-64 SECTION 4. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 152.2301, Human

2-1 Resources Code, are amended to read as follows:

2-2 (a) Throckmorton County is included in the 39th Judicial
2-3 District Juvenile Board. [~~The juvenile board of Throckmorton~~
2-4 ~~County is composed of the county judge, the district judges in~~
2-5 ~~Throckmorton County, and the judge of each statutory court~~
2-6 ~~designated as a juvenile court in the county. The juvenile court~~
2-7 ~~judge may appoint two public members to serve on the board for a~~
2-8 ~~period determined by the juvenile court judge.]~~

2-9 (b) Section 152.1101 applies to the 39th Judicial District
2-10 Juvenile Board. [~~The juvenile board shall elect one of its members~~
2-11 ~~as chairman at the beginning of each year.]~~

2-12 SECTION 5. Subsections (c), (d), and (e), Section 152.2301,
2-13 Human Resources Code, are repealed.

2-14 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
