- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.148, Government Code, as added by
- 6 Chapter 471 (H.B. 2188), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular
- 7 Session, 2007, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 8 follows:

- 9 (d) This section applies to information described by
- 10 Subsections (a) and (c) and to an item of information or comparable
- 11 sales data described by Subsection (b) only if the information,
- 12 <u>item of information, or comparable sales data relates to real</u>
- 13 property that is located in a county having a population of 20,000
- 14 or more.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
