1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the exception from required public disclosure of
1-11 certain appraisal district records.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 552.148, Government Code, as added by
1-14 Chapter 471 (H.B. 2188), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular
1-15 Session, 2007, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as
1-16 follows:

1-17 (d) This section applies to information described by
1-18 Subsections (a) and (c) and to an item of information or comparable
1-19 sales data described by Subsection (b) only if the information,
1-20 item of information, or comparable sales data relates to real
1-21 property that is located in a county having a population of 20,000
1-22 or more.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-27 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
