AN ACT

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- 2 relating to immunity from liability for doctors performing certain
- 3 services at the request of the division of workers' compensation of
- 4 the Texas Department of Insurance.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 413.054, Labor Code, is amended to read 7 as follows:
- 8 Sec. 413.054. IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY. (a) A person who
- 9 performs services for the division as a designated doctor, a doctor
- 10 performing a required medical examination or an independent medical
- 11 <u>examination</u> [examiner], a doctor performing a medical case review,
- 12 or a member of a peer review panel has the same immunity from
- liability as the commissioner under Section 402.00123 [402.0024].
- 14 (b) Immunity from liability under this section does not
- 15 apply to a person:
- 16 (1) providing medical treatment to an injured
- 17 employee; or

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- 18 (2) performing a service at the request of an
- 19 insurance carrier, injured employee, or injured employee's
- 20 <u>representative</u>.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
