The change in law made by this Act to Subsection 15 (c), Section 154.062, Family Code, applies only to a proceeding to establish or modify a child support obligation that is pending in a 16

trial court on or filed on or after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
