- 18 collateral to be sold, other than the inclusion of the motor vehicle
- 19 <u>in a list of the vehicles to be offered at the auction made</u>
- 20 available to potential bidders at the auction.
- 21 (b) The sale of the used motor vehicle constitutes a private
- 22 disposition for purposes of Chapter 9, Business & Commerce Code.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by Section 503.040,
- 24 Transportation Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a sale of

1 collateral consisting of a used motor vehicle that occurs on or

- 2 after the effective date of this Act. A sale of such collateral
- 3 that occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 4 law applicable to the sale immediately before the effective date of
- 5 this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
