## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to the continuation of the Texas Bleeding Disorders 2 3 Advisory Council. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 1, Chapter 994 (S.B. 1566), Acts of the 5 6 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, is amended by adding Subsection (i-1) and amending Subsections (k) and (n) to read as 7 follows: 8 (i-1) The commissioner may accept on behalf of the council 9 10 gifts, grants, and donations to fulfill the council's purposes 11 under this section. 12 (k) Not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year [ $\tau$ 

12 2008], the council shall report on its findings and recommendations 14 to the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the 15 house of representatives. The report shall be made public and is 16 subject to public review and comment before it may be adopted by the 17 council.

18 (n) This section expires and the council is abolished
19 September 1, <u>2013</u> [<del>2009</del>].

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
