## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to revenue received from the provision of pay telephone 3 service to inmates confined in facilities operated by the Texas 4 Department of Criminal Justice.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 495.025, Government 7 Code, as added by Chapter 100 (S.B. 1580), Acts of the 80th 8 Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, is reenacted to read as 9 follows:

10 shall transfer (c) The department 50 percent of all commissions paid to the department by a vendor under this section to 11 12 the compensation to victims of crime fund established by Subchapter 13 B, Chapter 56, Code of Criminal Procedure, and the other 50 percent to the credit of the undedicated portion of the general revenue 14 15 fund, except that the department shall transfer the first \$10 million of the commissions collected in any given year under a 16 contract awarded under this section to the compensation to victims 17 of crime fund established by Subchapter B, Chapter 56, Code of 18 19 Criminal Procedure. This section does not reduce any appropriation to the department. 20

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Chapter 1418 (H.B. 3107), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, money dedicated by Subsection (c), Section 495.025, Government Code, as added by Chapter 100 (S.B. 1580), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular

Session, 2007, to the compensation to victims of crime fund
established by Subchapter B, Chapter 56, Code of Criminal
Procedure, is rededicated by this Act.
