## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the reporting by candidates, officeholders, and 3 specific-purpose committees in connection with certain judicial 4 offices of political contributions and expenditures following the 5 end of the period during which those entities may accept political 6 contributions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

8 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 254, Election Code, is 9 amended by adding Section 254.0641 to read as follows:

Sec. 254.0641. ADDITIONAL REPORT OF JUDICIAL CANDIDATES.
(a) In addition to other required reports, a candidate for a
judicial office covered by Subchapter F, Chapter 253, shall file a
report as provided by this section.

14 (b) The report shall be filed not later than the 15th day after the last day on which the candidate may accept a political 15 contribution under Section 253.153(a)(2). The report covers the 16 period beginning the day the candidate's campaign treasurer 17 appointment is filed or the first day after the period covered by 18 the last report required to be filed under this chapter, as 19 applicable, and continuing through the last day on which the 20 candidate may accept a political contribution under Section 21 253.153(a)(2). 22

23 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 254, Election Code, is 24 amended by adding Section 254.0941 to read as follows:

Sec. 254.0941. ADDITIONAL REPORT OF JUDICIAL OFFICEHOLDERS. (a) In addition to other required reports, a holder of a judicial

4 provided by this section.

5 (b) The report shall be filed not later than the 15th day after the last day on which the officeholder may accept a political 6 7 contribution under Section 253.153(a)(2). The report covers the period beginning the day the officeholder files a campaign 8 treasurer appointment or the first day after the period covered by 9 the last report required to be filed under this chapter, as 10 applicable, and continuing through the last day on which the 11 12 officeholder may accept a political contribution under Section 13 253.153(a)(2).

## 14 SECTION 3. Subchapter E, Chapter 254, Election Code, is 15 amended by adding Section 254.1241 to read as follows:

Sec. 254.1241. ADDITIONAL REPORT OF CERTAIN COMMITTEES. (a)
In addition to other required reports, a specific-purpose committee
for supporting or opposing a candidate for or assisting a holder of
a judicial office covered by Subchapter F, Chapter 253, shall file a
report as provided by this section.

(b) The report shall be filed not later than the 15th day after the last day on which the committee may accept a political contribution under Section 253.153(a)(2). The report covers the period beginning the day the committee's campaign treasurer appointment is filed or the first day after the period covered by the last report required to be filed under this chapter, as applicable, and continuing through the last day on which the
