- 10 the orders or rules of a state agency if strict compliance with the
- 11 provisions, orders, or rules would in any way prevent, hinder, or
- 12 delay necessary action in coping with a disaster.

- (b) Upon declaration of a state of disaster, enforcement of
- 14 the regulation of on-premise outdoor signs under Subchapter A,
- 15 Chapter 216, Local Government Code, by a municipality that is
- 16 located in a county within, or that is located in a county adjacent
- 17 to a county within, the disaster area specified by the declaration
- 18 is suspended to allow licensed or admitted insurance carriers or
- 19 licensed agents acting on behalf of insurance carriers to erect
- 20 temporary claims service signage for not more than 30 days or until
- 21 the end of the declaration of disaster, whichever is earlier.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
